Requirements for Bidding (these requirements become part of the contract for the successful bidder):

• **Project Scope:**

1. Bidder stipulates that a site visit has been completed, has a complete understanding of the scope of work required, and has field verified said scope.
2. Mushroom feature: Remove and replace Mushroom feature pump and install new Mushroom feature pump with hair and lint strainer. Repair the pipe from the pit to the hair and lint strainer, from the pump to the return. To remove and replace all bolts, nuts, and washers on all valves and flanged couplings with stainless steel bolts, nuts, and washers. To install new flow meter per code. Remove and replace link belt seal between pit and front of pipe.
3. Surge Tanks: Install modulating valves and/or replace parts to make them work correctly for each main drain. Remove and replace all nuts, bolts, and washers with stainless steel nuts, bolts, and washers.
4. Stainless Steel Gutter System: Check for cracks at welds. Find and mark all leaks in gutter system. Have stainless steel welder repair all identified seams.
5. Main Pool: To pressure test and locate broken line on play features and repair as deemed necessary.

- To be considered for this request, the office of the County Treasurer must receive a complete bid package using this form by **12:00 p.m., Thursday, September 15, 2016.**
- Bids should be submitted in a sealed envelope with the company name, street address, bid due date and project name. **Aquatic Center Work** clearly marked. Bids should be delivered to Melissa Horn, County Treasurer, Oldham County Fiscal Court at the above address.
- Oldham County reserves the right to make adjustments in the field. Change Orders must be used and approved in advance any price difference is incurred.
- All bidders and their employees, assigns, subcontractors, etc. must be fully covered by Workman's Compensation. Certificate of Liability Insurance must be included with the bid.
- All bids must be signed.
- Successful bidders must be in good standing with the Kentucky Secretary of State, the Kentucky Revenue Cabinet and must not be debarred or excluded from federal work.
- Bids will be opened on September 20, 2016, during the regularly scheduled public Fiscal Court meeting.
