Requirements for bidding (these requirements become part of the contract for the successful bidder):

Project Scope:

The selected contractor will be responsible for, and the bid should include costs associated with;

1. Demolition of damaged wall
2. Removal and proper off-site disposal of debris
3. Construct new wall to match existing walls
4. Replace all damaged caps to match existing caps
5. Mortar & joint all caps
6. Re-install two existing lamps
7. Responsible for getting all products used to complete job to match all existing walls

Submittal

- **All bidders must attend a pre-bid meeting on Monday, April 17, 2017 at 2:00 p.m. at the job site: 100 West Main Street, LaGrange, KY 40031.**
- To be considered for this request, the office of the County Treasurer must receive a complete bid package using this form by **Tuesday, April 25, 2017 at 12:00 pm EST.**
- Bids should be submitted in a sealed envelope with the company name, street address, bid due date and project name: **Brick Wall Repair** clearly marked. Bid should be delivered to Melissa Horn, County Treasurer at the above address.

- All bidders and their employees, assigns, subcontractors, etc. must be fully covered by Workers Compensation. Certificate of Liability Insurance must be included with the bid.
- All bids must be signed.
- Successful bidders must be in good standing with the Kentucky Secretary of State, the Kentucky Revenue Cabinet and must not be excluded from federal work. These requirements must be adhered to by all Kentucky and out of state corporations, limited liability companies, professional services corporations, nonprofit corporations, limited partnerships and business trusts. Sole proprietorships must be registered/filed with the county where the business is located. A certificated copy of the registration must be included with the bid. Sole proprietors must not be excluded from federal work and should not have outstanding indebtedness with the Kentucky Revenue Cabinet.
- Bids will be opened on Tuesday, May 2, 2017 at 2:00 p.m., during the scheduled, public Fiscal Court meeting.
