Items Too Big For Your Trash Bin

Republic Services (502) 638-9000
Oldham County and LaGrange franchise customers may set out one large item per week on their collection day. All mattresses left out for pick up must be wrapped in plastic. Customers **must** schedule bulk pick up a business day in advance. This can be done by phone or online at Republic.com. Republic allows residential customers under franchise agreement to take, at any time during normal operating hours, bulky items or extra garbage and yard waste to Valley View Landfill. Bring a current service bill and call in advance. See details below.

Hours: M-F - 7:00 am-4:00 pm and 2nd & 4th Sat. of each month - 8:00 am noon
Fees: No fees for hauling standard household items and yard waste by residents of Oldham County and LaGrange who pay Republic directly or in their water bill. Bring a current trash service bill and proof of identity. Customers must be capable of unloading their own items. Minimum \$75/truckload fee applies for other items, such as construction, remodeling & demolition debris; and for other customers.
