Requirements for bidding (the requirements become part of the contract for the successful bidder):

Project Scope:

The selected contractor will be responsible for, and the bid should include costs associated with;

- Construction of 1,194 linear feet of perennial stream channel, 225 linear feet of intermittent stream channel, and 134 linear feet of ephemeral stream channel including all channel grading and installation of in-stream structures
- Planting of 3.22 acres of forested stream riparian corridor with native seed and trees
- Construction of 1.62 acres of forested wetland including grading, native seeding and native tree planting.
- A CD of Bid Documents is available upon request or at the Pre-bid meeting.

Submittal Requirements: (These requirements become part of the contract for successful bidder):

- For those interested, a Pre-bid meeting will be held on Monday August 20 at 2 pm in the second floor conference room of the Fiscal Court building followed by a site visit.
- To be considered for this request, the office of the County Judge Executive must receive a complete RFP package using this form by **Friday, August 31, 2018 by 12:00 pm.**
- Bids will be opened on Tuesday September 4, 2018 at 2 p.m. during the scheduled Fiscal Court meeting.
- Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope with the company name, street address, bid due date and project name: **"Stream and Wetland Restoration"** clearly marked. Submittals shall be delivered to Melissa Horn, County Treasurer at the above address.
- The bidder shall document that they are qualified and capable of successfully completing the Project. Contractor shall provide proof of completion of three or more successful stream and wetland mitigation/restoration projects of similar size and scope within the last five years along with their bids.
- All bid forms must be signed.
- Successful consultants must be in good standing with the Kentucky Secretary of State, the Kentucky Revenue Cabinet, and must not be debarred or excluded from federal work before award of the contract.

- Bid proposal shall remain unaltered unless bidder is directed otherwise by amendment.
- It is the bidder's responsibility to receive and respond to any and all amendments.
- All items/components of the project must be included in the bid.
