## OLDHAM COUNTY EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

### OPEN BURN RESTRICTIONS LIFTED

September 30, 2021

The Federal Environmental Protection Agency mandated Open Burn Restrictions for Oldham County will be lifted between October 1, 2021, and April 30, 2022. All open burns must be reported to Oldham County Central Dispatch at 222-0111. Open burns are for natural growth only; no trash or construction materials. All burns must be at least 150 feet from any woodland or brushland and be supervised at all times.
