Requirements for bidding (these requirements become part of the contract for the successful bidder):

Project Scope:

- ~ Bidder is responsible for removing all existing materials
- ~ Bidder is responsible for install of all new product - per code requirements
- ~ Bidder is responsible for any and all structural repair, prep work
- ~ Bidder is responsible for all debris removal in proper manner, all materials and equipment to complete the job,
- ~ Bidder is responsible for any and all permits and inspections if necessary

Submittal

- **All bidders must arrange a pre-bid meeting to view the job site (100 W Jefferson St., LaGrange KY 40031) with Rodney Gabbert (502-664-7694) or rgabbert@OldhamCountyKy.gov prior to Friday, April 3.**
- To be considered for this request, the office of the County Treasurer must receive a complete bid package using this form by **Friday, April 3 at 12:00 p.m.**
- Bids should be submitted in a sealed envelope with the company name, street address, bid due date and project name: **Fiscal Courthouse – Tile Flooring** clearly marked. Bid should be delivered to Melissa Horn, County Treasurer at the above address. Bids sent via email will not be accepted.
- All bidders and their employees, assigns, subcontractors, etc. must be fully covered by Workers Compensation. Certificate of Liability Insurance must be included with the bid.
- All bids must be signed.
- Successful bidders must be in good standing with the Kentucky Secretary of State, the Kentucky Revenue Cabinet and must not be excluded from federal work. These requirements must be adhered to by all Kentucky and out of state corporations, limited liability companies, professional services corporations, nonprofit corporations, limited partnerships and business trusts. Sole proprietorships must be registered/ filed with the county where the business is located. A certificated copy of the registration must be included with the bid. Sole proprietors must not be excluded from federal work and should not have outstanding indebtedness with the Kentucky Revenue Cabinet.
- Bids will be opened on Tuesday, April 7, 2020 at 2:00 p.m., during the scheduled, public Fiscal Court meeting.
