ADDRESS IDENTIFICATION

In any type of emergency, you want help to arrive as quickly as possible. When every second counts, it is imperative our fire, police and EMS professionals are able to quickly and easily locate your home or office. We want to be there for **YOU**, so please, review your current address identification markers. Make sure your address is clearly marked following the guidelines listed below.

- Mark **BOTH** sides of your mailbox so your address can be viewed from either direction traveling along the roadway.
- Use Arabic numerals with a **MINIMUM of 3"** in height (see back for sizing.)
- Use reflective numbers or contrasting colors for higher visibility.
- If you do not have a mailbox, place a two-sided signpost in the front yard close to the curb with numbers visible from both sides.
- Clear any landscaping or decorative items that may obstruct viewing.
- Display the address on the front structure of your home or office in a way that is readily visible from the roadway.
- Test viewing the address yourself after dark. If you can't see it, neither can we!
