The Meeting Summary of the November 21, 2013 meeting was reviewed and approved.

Comprehensive Plan Update- Goals & Objectives: - Brian Davis stated that Fiscal Court approved the Goals and Objectives on Tuesday, December 3, 2013 by unanimous vote.

Comprehensive Plan Update- Plan Elements: - Brian Davis distributed a draft copy of the Plan Elements. On page 58 new language was added regarding law enforcement in Oldham County. The information was obtained from each agency's website.

A motion was made and seconded to add the language as written regarding law enforcement. Motion carried with all members voting yes.

School information was updated and included the new redistricting plan along with an elementary map and table.

A motion was made and seconded to add the language and edits as written regarding education. Motion carried with all members voting yes.

Mr. Davis present all the changed that were made from the recommendations from the previous meeting.

A motion was made and seconded to adopt the changes as presented. Motion carried with all members voting yes.

The Future Land Use Map will be presented to the committee for review at the January meeting.

Zoning Ordinance Prioritization: - Jim Urban stated that the Zoning Ordinance will be reviewed next and asked the committee members to begin making a list of items that they feel need to be addressed. Staff will provide a list of items in the Zoning Ordinance that need to be addressed as well and the prioritization process will begin.

Official Zoning Map Discussion: - Brian Davis stated that staff would like to eventually adopt the GIS electronic map as the official zoning map. The current GIS electronic map has discrepancies relating to the CO-1 zoning layer. Staff will work with the new GIS manager, Matt Tolar, to overlay the official zoning map from 1969 and correct the electronic GIS CO-1 layer to match the official zoning map.

Staff will work on the mapping project and bring a draft to the January 23, 2013 meeting for review and possible recommendation to the legislative bodies.

The Study Review Committee will plan to meet again on January 23, 2013 at 5:00 p.m.
